Greenwood Christian Academy offers spiritual training that is aimed at bringing students into a correct relationship with God through Jesus Christ, while maintaining a strong academic program.

As a Christian school, we are committed to the teaching of the Bible and are persuaded that there should be a direct relationship between what Christian students believe and how they behave.

Very specific requirements for admission have been established for each student desiring to enroll. The most important of these requirements are summarized below:

ADMISSION POLICY

1. The Board of Directors requires at least one parent submit a clearly written personal salvation testimony that provides evidence of a personal relationship with Jesus Christ.
2. Each prospective enrollee must have a minimum grade point average of 2.0 for the last year of academic studies.
3. One or both of the above criteria may be waived by recommendation of the Administration.
4. Each student must demonstrate that he/she has a behavioral history that would be in accordance with the standards and expectations of our school.

SUBMITTING AN APPLICATION

New applications will be processed in the numeric order received. Promptness is important in returning your application material due to the possibility of a waiting list in each class.

All applications are reviewed without regard to sex, race and national or ethnic origin.

TESTING

Students may be tested to ensure their readiness for the academics at GCA. Generally this testing will be in the areas of math and language arts.

INTERVIEW

If a student's application is favorable, an interview with the prospective student(s) and parents will be scheduled.

The purpose of the interview is to answer questions and familiarize the student(s) and parents with our school and to make a final determination relative to enrollment.

NOTIFICATION OF ACCEPTANCE/REJECTION

1. Due to limited enrollment opportunities, numerous applicants and very definite enrollment criteria, we are not able to enroll all students desiring to do so. Therefore, parents/students should not presume that enrollment is automatic.
2. Parents/guardians will receive written notification as soon as possible of any student's acceptance/rejection.

Parents' Statement of Cooperation

1. We(I) have read the Student Handbook and will cooperate with the school to see that our(my) child meets the standard of appearance and conduct as outlined therein. We(I) furthermore grant the school the authority to discipline our child as necessary (as outlined in the Student Handbook) and agree to cooperate with discipline of our(my) child at home as needed.
2. We(I) agree to bring any questions or criticisms regarding procedures or discipline directly to the administration or teacher involved. We(I) will not be party to rumors. We(I) will not spread discontent among our(my) child(ren) or other parents.
3. We(I) have read the school's doctrinal statement, purpose and objectives and are(am) willing to have our(my) child trained in accordance with them.
4. We(I) give permission for our(my) child to take part in all school activities, including sports and school-sponsored trips away from the school premises and absolve the school from any liability because of injury.
5. We(I) agree to pay the tuition according to arrangements that shall be made, and understand that any monthly payments not made by noon on the first business day after the fifteenth (15th) of the month will result in a \$15.00 late fee assessed the next month's invoice. If our(my) account becomes more than 30 days delinquent, our(my) child may be temporarily suspended from school. If financial problems arise, we(I) understand that the school will work with us in making special payment arrangements.
6. We(I) agree to support the high academic standards of the school by providing a place at home for our(my) child to study and by giving our(my) child encouragement in the completion of homework and assignments.
7. We(I) realize that a Christian school is not a substitute for the local church. Christian education is complete when a child receives instruction from the home, Christian school, and Bible-teaching church. We(I) agree to pray for the ministry of the school, staff members, school board and fellow families as we join in partnership with GCA in order to help us(me) with our spiritual responsibility to our child.
